How this module works

If this module is enabled, you can use UPS to fetch real time shipping quotes for your store. You don't actually need to ship UPS, as UPS is not processing any shipping requests. It is merely grabbing calculations dependent on weight and zip code. You can then ship any method you choose, but you get a full set of rates automatically calculated for all orders.

If you do not have a UPS account, you can Register here.

As an end-user, you must login to your country's UPS E-Business web site with your UserId and Password. A license agreement must be accepted on the "OnLine Tools" section at your country's UPS E-Business web site. After accepting the appropriate Tools licensing agreement, a Developer Key will be e-mailed to the registered user. You need to permanently save a copy of your Developer Key for future reference. A valid **Developer Key is needed to obtain an Access Key**. You can obtain your XML Access Key on the "Access Key" section of your country's UPS E-Business web site.

The UPS module in AmazaCart retrieves all shipping methods from the UPS server. By editing the fields, you can globally adjust how much UPS will calculate the shipping charges to be. There is a test section at the bottom where you can test each change you make to any of the settings.

- **Access Key:** You need to have a UPS account to be able to use this feature. If you do not have one then you can register at www.ups.com. Once you register you can apply for an Access Key.
- **Pickup type:** Changing the type of pickup you have will modify how UPS calculates the amount. You can even use this field to artificially change the calculations so that they are more in line (when you do test orders) of what you really want to be charging your customers.

Fill out the remaining fields for how you want UPS to calculate costs on all orders. Again, you can choose different settings to get the charges to where you want them to be (for instance if you want the charges to be \$2-\$3 more than the actual charges for the handling time and materials involved).
